RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) All exhibits shown must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor. No rail-stock accepted.
- 2) All birds to be penned by 0930h. Judging commences 1000h prompt. Boxing may commence at 4pm. No birds to leave the tent until all are accounted for.
- 3) We will only accept entries on time, in writing and with the full entry fee.
- 4) In the event of only one bird or exhibitor in the class the show reserves the right to amalgamate within its breed class / colour or any other variety class.
- 5) All birds are to be fed and watered by exhibitors after judging has taken place. The stewards will not be responsible for this.
- 6) All exhibitors are to park vehicles to the rear of the poultry tent.
- 7) All eggs must be fresh and the produce of the exhibitor. The bleaching of eggs or any artificial preparation of the same will disqualify the entry.
- 8) Exhibitor concessions: Five entries or more by one exhibitor will receive one free entrance pass. S.A.E. to be enclosed with entries to receive this pass.
- 9) If the Judge wishes the tent to be closed for judging then it will be closed.

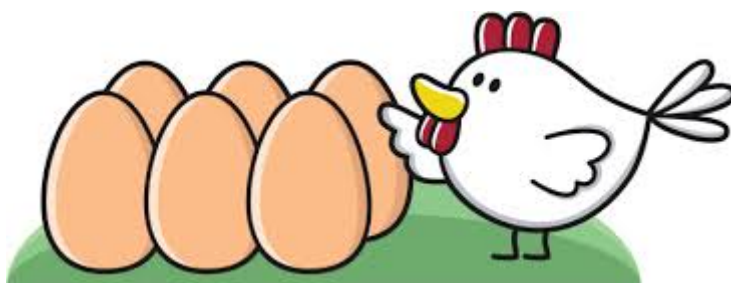
