



In accordance with the Bedwellty Show Society requirements regarding Equine Influenza, the Society must ask exhibitors to fill in this declaration, stating that their animals abide by our vaccination requirements and are therefore allowed to attend the event. Checks will be carried out at the point of entry and throughout the show

Vaccination Requirement

The society expects all equine entries to have an up-to-date equine influenza vaccination record. They must have received two primary vaccinations which are given not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart. If sufficient time has elapsed the equine entry must also have received a booster vaccination which is given not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the second component of the primary vaccination, and further booster vaccinations at intervals of not more than a year apart. None of the vaccinations must have been given on the day of entry to the showground or on any of the six days before entry to the showground.

Note: Minimum requirements are the two primary vaccinations, plus seven days before entry to the showground.

Exhibitors are requested to read and sign this declaration and produce a copy upon arrival at the Show. FAILURE TO PRODUCE THIS DOCUMENT DULY SIGNED WILL RESULT IN YOUR EXHIBITS BEING PREVENTED FROM ENTERING THE SHOWGROUND.

I/We hereby declare that the animals being exhibited have been vaccinated against Equine Influenza, in accordance with the vaccination requirements displayed above and are eligible to attend the 2019 Bedwellty Agricultural Show.
